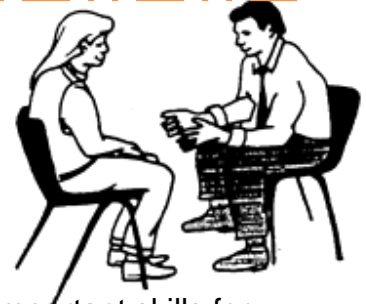

**Course Title:** Enjoy Science In English

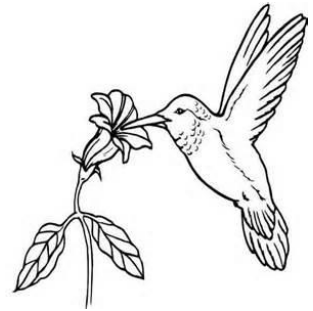

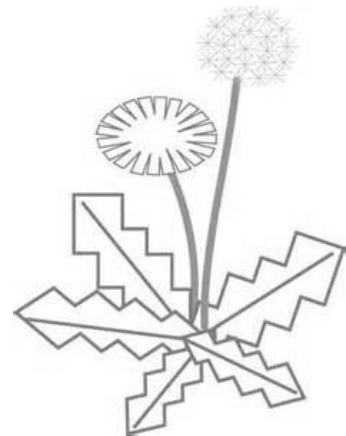
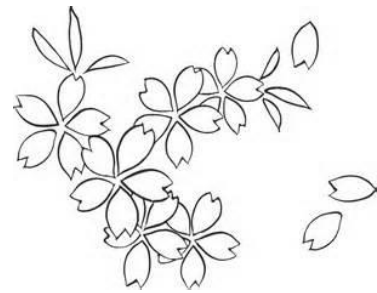

- ◇ **A Critical Look at the TV Fantasy Series, "Lost" (First Season)**

This course will focus on the episodes from the first season of the U.S. science-fiction and fantasy adventure TV drama series, "Lost," which ran from 2004 to 2010. The show begins with a plane crash somewhere in the Pacific Ocean en route from Sydney to Los Angeles, and continues with the story of the survivors' lives on a mysterious island. Each class session will consist of the viewing of two episodes, followed by discussions of their contents. Students will be expected to write down and learn the new vocabulary encountered in the course of viewing. At the end of the course, students will take a quiz (vocabulary, contents, general interpretation) and give individual presentations on their favorite character. No formal grade will be given, but an assessment will be based on both on regular attendance and participation (50%) and the quiz and presentations (50%).
