Course Title: Future World Scenarios: Problems and Solutions

Course Description: This weeklong intensive course is geared to those students wishing to improve their English oral expression skills, particularly those of discussion, debate and presentation. The topics to be treated will come from various textbooks and other sources, with printouts to be handed out in class. The themes will include such topics as global warming, overpopulation, nuclear war, and terrorism, and will be chosen in consultation with the students on the first day. Critical thinking strategies will be emphasized as students become more effective speakers.


- ◇ 対象:東京工業大学に学籍のある学生
