

EPFL – Tokyo Tech Student Workshop Call for Applications (Deadline extended)

1. Workshop Purpose

Student Workshops, mainly for the undergraduate students (3rd or 4th year) and graduate students (1st year of master course) in School of Materials and Chemical Technology are held between EPFL (École Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne) and Tokyo Institute of Technology at Tokyo Tech in August, 2018 and at Lausanne in March, 2019 in order to exchange cultural knowledge and promote interactions across academic disciplines through the workgroup including hackathon.

2. Workshop Outline

Workshop at Tokyo Tech will be held on August 28-31. About 48 EPFL students will visit Tokyo Tech. Tokyo Tech students of 3rd-4th year of undergraduate, and 1st year of master course will join in cities". They are encouraged to have discussion and exchange their own cultures, disciplines and personal experiences to find solution on the issue on sustainable society.

In March, 2019, there is a plan to visit EPFL to have the second workshop to continue and explore for further solution.

- ⑤ Keywords on your interest and/or concerns (less than 5)
- ⑥ Expectation to join workshop at EPFL in march, 2019 (Yes or No)
- ⑦ About yourself
- ⑧ English test score (TOEIC, TOFEL, or IELTS, if English is your second language. Not be requested to send your score. The score of two years ago (or more) is also effective)
